

# #6670: `str.chars.last` should be possible

```
"foo".chars.last      #=> NoMethodError  
"foo".chars.to_a.last  #=> "o"
```

I feel it's hard to explain why `"to_a"` is needed here for Ruby beginners.

Easiest impl: make `String#chars` to return `Array` (and keep `#each_char` as is)
