

## Feature #4778 : IO#each\_chomped

```
IO#each_line:  
yield "first line\n"  
yield "second line\n"  
yield "third line\n"  
...
```

Proposition:

```
IO#each_chomped (or IO#each_chomped_line, ... ?):  
yield "first line"  
yield "second line"  
yield "third line"  
...
```

No easy and efficient way to do it currently :

- ▶ `map(&:chomp)` : memory usage
- ▶ `each(&:chomp!)` : no chaining (except if an Array of lines), and likely need explicit assignment and 3 lines (assign, `chomp!`, treatment)

However, most of the time that final `"\n"` is not useful at all!
