<b>Description</b>		
<p>Pretty self-explanatory: allow removal of individual <code>define_finalizer</code> blocks without removing all of them as <code>undefine_finalizer</code> currently does.</p> <p>From an API standpoint, this could be done by having <code>define_finalizer</code> return some sort of unique value (maybe an integer, or perhaps the type is unspecified), and this value could then be passed as <code>undefine_finalizer</code>'s second argument to remove just that finalizer.</p>
