#### Description

test-all reports varying test counts from build to build. This seems to be due to duplicate class names in the test suite.

I pushed [PR 1763](#) to the git repo with several renamed classes.

I've been using the patch in ruby-loco MinGW builds. The test summary page [Ruby MinGW Test Results](#) has shown consistent results.

Also, I did a build in my [fork](#), which showed a test count of 16,826, which matches the test count in the [PR build](#).
