I was experimenting with how multiple documents in one file are processed by YAML. I went to the yaml specification site and copied
an example there(http://yaml.org/spec/current.html).
In irb:
str = "---
time: 20:03:20
player: Sammy Sosa
action: strike (miss)
...

time: 20:03:47
player: Sammy Sosa
action: grand slam
..."
YAML::load_documents(str){|d| puts d.inspect}

results in: {"player"=>"Sammy Sosa", "action"=>"strike (miss)", "time"=>72200}
