<p>rb_profile_frames(), which is the backend of stackprof, shows only ruby frames, so sometimes it is difficult to find a bottleneck in an application.</p> <p>This will be gradually solved by "rubifying" all builtin methods (#16254), but I guess it will take a few years at least. So, how about showing cfunc frames in the profiled result that returns rb_profile_frames()?</p> <p>Here is a patch and an example stackprof result:</p> <p>https://github.com/ruby/ruby/pull/3299</p>
