Kernel#gem in gem\_prelude.rb accepts ">", ">=", and "=" (with your patch), but they behave the completely same. This feature does not work correctly at all, I think. Though it may be intended behavior since the original code was committed at [r14011](#) by Eric himself.

Anyway, it is too late to fix this issue for 1.9.2. In addition, I *think* it is no use waiting for this issue to be fixed, even if the release is postponed. Really hopeless.

I think this issue should be fixed in 1.9.3, by the approach of nobu's patch in [#3140](#).
