But wrong in 1.8:  ruby-1.8 -ve 'class C<Struct.new(:a);def initialize;end;end;p Marshal.load(Marshal.dump(C.new))' ruby 1.8.7 (2011-06-30 patchlevel 352) [x86_64-linux] -e:1:in initialize': wrong number of arguments (1 for 0) (ArgumentError) from -e:1:inload' from -e:1
