Description =begin As this is a problem with the documentation, there are no steps required to reproduce it. My Ruby version is currently ruby 2.0.0p0 (2013-02-24 revision 39474) [x86_64-darwin11.4.2], but this documentation problem appears to have been in Ruby since at least ruby 1.9.3p194 (2012-04-20 revision 35410) [x86_64-darwin11.4.0]. Problem: The second example of the (<code>Forwardable</code>) module in stdlib appears to be a mish-mash of two separate and incompatible examples. It begins by defining delegates for a (<code>RecordCollection</code>) class, but then goes on to make a new instance of the (<code>Foo</code>) class (never defined), calling methods on that instance that are also never defined. Expected: I expected it to show a new instance of the (<code>RecordCollection</code>) class and to call the methods that were delegated in the first parts of the example (<code>record_number, :size, :<<, :map</code>). =end
